Dear Yeshiva Scholarship Applicant,

First we like to congratulate you for choosing the path of Jewish education and wish you a successful academic year.

The Yeshiva Scholarship Committee is established to make sure that every Mashadi student gets a chance to go to a Jewish School. Our goal is to help the students financially to the best of our ability, so that attending a Jewish School can become easier for them.

However, as you know, our budget is limited. In order for us to accommodate you with your needs, we would like you to note the following rules:

- a. **Fill one application of 2017-2018, entirely and neatly, for each student.**
- b. **Bring us a copy of the student's tuition bill. Without the copy of tuition bill your application will automatically be denied.**
- c. **Let us know in advance if the student is being granted with any other financial aid.**
- d. **All students must first directly apply for his/her school's scholarship.**
- e. **If you are a new applicant, you will be granted for a scholarship only if you are participating in a school that has accepted the UMJCA Guidelines.**
- f. **Deliver your completed application together with other mentioned documents in a sealed envelope to one of the following committee members by August 15th 2017:**

For North Shore Hebrew Academy, Mr. Moossa Levian.

For all other schools, Mr. Benny Hematian, Mr. Edo Livi, Mr. Moris Aziz, Mr. George Dilamani, Mr. Yossi Nassimi, and Mr. Louis Ebrani

Unfortunately, if you fail to follow these guidelines, you may lose your chance of receiving a scholarship from us.

We need you to support the community with some kind of voluntary work. We urge all the parents to encourage their children to participate in the community affairs and help us in our events.

Please look at these scholarships as a loan from community to you and try to pay back when G-D willing you are able to do so.
