Dear Yeshiva Scholarship Applicant,

First we like to congratulate you for choosing the path of Jewish education and wish you a successful academic year.

The Yeshiva Scholarship Committee is established to make sure that every Mashadi student gets a chance to go to a Jewish School. Our goal is to financially help the students to the best of our ability, so that attending a Jewish School can become more affordable to them.

For a faster process, you can now submit your applications online as well, however we still need a copy of the tuition bill to be sent to us.

In order to accommodate you with your needs, we would like you to note the following guidelines:

- a. **Submit one application per Student for 2019-2020. If the information you submit is not complete or clear, we will void your application.**
- b. **Bring us a copy of the student's tuition bill. Without the copy of tuition bill your application will automatically be denied.**
- c. **Please specify in your application if the student is being granted with any other financial aid. (Very important)**
- d. **All students MUST apply first for his/her school's scholarship.**
- e. **If you are a new applicant, you will be granted for a scholarship only if you are participating in a school that has accepted the UMJCA Guidelines.**
- f. **Send the above documents in a sealed envelope to one of the following committee members by August 15th 2019. After this date we will not review your application:**

Unfortunately, if you do not follow these guidelines, you may lose your chance of receiving a scholarship from us.
