As Pesach cleaning begins and preparations are underway, we understand that many community members will have sefarim, siddurim, and other Judaic materials requiring proper Geniza.

Shaare Shalom is here to assist. We kindly request that all items be **properly bagged or boxed, clearly labeled “Geniza,” and dropped off at the Security Office.**

Please note that this service carries a cost for the Kanissa. Those who are able and feel motivated are encouraged to leave a donation of any amount with **Minoo or Nushin in the Kanissa office**, labeled “Geniza,” to help support this important service.

Additionally, we respectfully ask that you **do not place siddurim, sefarim, or other books on the Kanissa shelves.** Any items left on shelves will be assumed to be discarded and will be placed directly into Geniza or garbage without review.

Chametz Policy Reminder:

- The last day to bring Chametz into the sanctuaries is **Saturday, March 21st.**
- The last day for any events in the building involving Chametz is **Sunday, March 22nd.**
